FAQs

What is the difference between IMS1 Live and IMS1 Online?

Integrated Movement Science Level 1 live will be completed by attending a 5 day in-person class.

Integrated Movement Science Level 1 online contains 11 courses, and one exam. Once you have access to IMS1 online, you will work through each course by either watching a series of videos, followed by a quiz after each course, or completing a case study. Completion of IMS1 online will take approximately 40 hours. After completion of the online material, you will be required to attend a one-day in-person live assessment day. You must complete all 11 courses and pre-requisites in order to attend the assessment day.

Where will live classes take place?

You will be registered for IMS1 live or the IMS1 assessment day in accordance with the location preferences expressed in your Learning Agreement. You will be notified of the chosen date by email 90 days after commencement of the Academy.

What are the pre-requisite courses for IMS1?

The pre-requisite requirements for the Integrated Movement Science Level 1 program are as follows.

Completion of:

- Scientific Core Conditioning and exam
- Scientific Back Training 2nd edition and exam (Note that the 1st edition is no longer accepted as a pre-requisite.)
- Program Design 2nd edition and exam. (Note that the 1st edition is no longer accepted as a pre-requisite.)

What equipment is needed?

The following equipment is required for your assessment: 1. Eye Make-up Pencil 2. Plumline 3. Single (Spinal) Inclinometer 4. CHEK Inclinometer 5. CHEK Calliper (Head Carriage) 6. Blood Pressure Cuff/Biofeedback Unit 7. Swiss Ball or Exercise Bench 8. Tape measure 9. Dowel Rod/Stick 10. Mirror 11. Credit Card/Business Card.

The equipment is usually supplied at the venue, however you can purchase the IMS1 tools bundle from the CHEK Shop.

If you have your own CHEK tools and wish to bring them along, please feel free to do so. If you don't have the CHEK Inclinometer and/or CHEK Calliper, you will need to use the alternative methods taught on the course to take the measurements (using a Single Inclinometer and Ruler (and/or Tape Measure), Plumline or Necklace).

What happens if I can't attend IMS1 live course or assessment day?

You will be notified of the class allocated to you and you will have 14 days to let us know if that date isn't suitable. We will work to change you to an alternative class, however, this is not always possible.

If you later decide that you are unable to attend, we will do our best to change you to another Academy class and that would be without charge. If you need to transfer to a non-Academy class, we will charge the transfer fee detailed in the Learning Agreement.

You will be responsible for paying a transfer fee if you simply fail to attend, or need to be transferred out of the class due to the fact that you have not completed your pre-requisite courses in time.

What is the Fast Track Series?

This is a series of workshops designed to provide you with a practical insight into the learning material. This content is offered exclusively to Academy students.

These workshops are optional but are highly recommended. They are designed to enhance your CHEK Academy journey by giving you the skills to practically apply the knowledge.

Are the Mentorship Calls mandatory?

Attendance at mentor calls is optional, however strongly recommended. This is an opportunity to ask your questions, and connect with your fellow students. If you are unable to attend, the recording will be available in your Mentorship Group Call Learning Path.

How does online learning work?

You will access your learning material via your online learning account, where you will see a learning path containing your academic content for the year, as well as a learning path containing mentor call dates and recordings.

You will start your academic content by completing the first workshop. Once that is completed, the next course will automatically unlock and you will continue until the end of the academic year. This means that you can unlock the courses at your own pace and you don't need to wait until the following month to continue your studies.

What if I've already completed courses?

You will be able to move through any courses which you've already completed, without having to work through them again.

What do the deadlines look like?

You should aim to complete the online material for each month by the end of the month.

You will see the deadlines for Pre-Requisite Courses and Advanced Training Programs under "Exam Deadlines" in the Academic plan.

When do I receive my CHEK Practitioner Level 1 license?

You will receive your CHEK Practitioner Level 1 license at the end of Year 1 (after completion of the IMS1 exam). The license is included in Academy fees once all of the year has been completed. You will then be invited to monthly webinars and have access to further Level 1 resources.
